Ride Checklist

- · What to bring:
 - a) Helmet (no exceptions)
 - b) A bike in good mechanical order
 - c) Spare tube, pump, tyre levers, a full water bottle and any other tools you may require
 - d) When appropriate: sunscreen, rain jacket, money for food, fares and your mobile phone
- Children will often struggle to keep up with adult groups, so don't bring children without checking with the ride leader before the day of the ride; all children (under 18) need to ride with a responsible adult and remain under the control of that adult for the duration of the ride; Parents and Guardians must read the Risk Warning and agree that the Ride Terms apply to their children
- Talk to the ride leader now if you are in doubt about your ability to complete the ride, or have a medical condition or injury that may become an issue during a ride

Risk Warning

Cycling can be an enjoyable and exciting activity. However, like many recreational activities that require physical exertion, cycling carries with it the risk of physical injury, which may result from your or your children's actions or the actions of others. The risks associated with cycling include the risks that you or your children may:

- Fall from your bicycle or be involved in a collision with pedestrians, animals, objects, other cyclists (including those in a BayBUG group) and/or vehicles
- Suffer from the effects of heat, cold, wind, rain and other weather conditions
- Suffer from physical exertion, for example because a ride or part of a ride is beyond your physical capacity; if you have a pre-existing injury or illness, participating in a ride could make that injury or illness worse
- Be distracted by other riders or pay less attention to road risks because you are in a group
- · Become separated from the cycling group
- Lose control of your bicycle, suffer injury or loss because of pavement or terrain conditions, mechanical failure or punctures

These risks may result in death, bodily injury, disability, property damage and economic loss. The risks for children and beginner riders are increased by their lack of cycling skills, road experience and knowledge of road rules. There are other risks to which you may be exposed.

Ride Terms

By participating in the cycling activities provided by BayBUG, you agree:

- (a) To obey and ensure that children that you supervise obey all Australia and NSW road rules, including wearing an Australian standards approved helmet
- (b) To take full and sole responsibility for children that you are supervising and if you are a parent or guardian whose children are participating, that in these terms "you" and "your" refer to you and your children
- (c) That you participate at your own risk; that the agreement for services provided to you by BayBUG does not include any implied or express warranty that the services of BayBUG will be rendered with due care and skill, or that any materials provided by BayBUG in connection with the cycling activities will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied
- (d) That BayBUG's ride leader determines if a ride is run and when and where it pauses and finishes; you must leave a ride if the ride leader asks you to do so
- (e) That BayBUG has no liability to you for personal injury or death arising from the services that BayBUG provides to you
- (f) That your details provided on this registration may be seen by BayBUG's agents and other organisations involved in organising BayBUG rides that you participate in
- (g) To indemnify BayBUG, BayBUG's agents and other organisations involved in organising BayBUG rides against any claim, loss, damage, liability, cost and expense that may be incurred or sustained by any of them in connection with any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by you or which was in any way connected with your involvement in the cycling activities
